BOSTON SUSPECTS CAUGHT

Freedom! Boston is free from staying in their houses! On Friday, April 19, 2013, at 8:45 p.m. Dzhokhar Tsarnaev was caught in a boat in a Boston native's backyard. The owner of the boat was looking out at his boat and saw a rip in his boat cover. He then went outside to see it to find Tsarnaev. He immediately went inside and called 911. Police hurried and caught him. He was bloody because of the two shots fired in a gunfight earlier that day. He was rushed to the hospital and was not immediately able to talk. He wrote saying his older brother Tamerlan Tsarnaev, 26, told him to help start this attack using pressure cooker bombs. Since he listened to everything his older brother said, he agreed. They are also suspected to shooting Massachusetts Institute of Technology police officer Sean Collier, 26, on April 18. Despite Dzhokhar's confession, his parents say their sons are innocent and are being framed.



Their father said he was going to come to Boston to bury Tamerlan. Recently, police have taken Dzhokhar to Devens Federal Medical Center a prison in Fort Devens, Massachusetts. It is a prison for men who need longterm care, specialized care or mental health care. Tsarnaev is said to have gunshot wounds in his head and neck. His injuries prevented him from speaking. He also has injures on his leg and hand from the shootout that killed his brother when his brother died. The Federal government says he is now able to talk and also admitted that he and his brother planned to carry-out another attack at Times Square. The whole motive behind this attack was to defend Islam due to the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. His parents will not be allowed to visit him in prison because they think they have been framed. In conclusion, the terriost, Dzhokhar Tsarnaev has been caught and is now being held in custody. Now Boston can start putting closure to the tragic bombing attack on April 15, 2013.


